Please do not forget your duck call, boots, and of course your camo. We will have lunches for sale at the hunt headquarters at noon on Sat. & Sun. Don't forget to join us for our complimentary tailgate supper on Saturday night. It promises to be another good one as always.

We ask you to **remind your spectators (guests) not to wear white or light colored clothing** at the hunt sites because this may interfere with the dogs that are running.

Raffles!!! We will have our Traditional raffle on Saturday night.

Bitch Check!!! Those of you entering female dogs please plan to be at the hunt headquarters for bitch check around 7:00am. You will not be placed in a running order with marshals until you have received a "Clear Check" card.

Please go to bitch check before checking in with the hunt secretary and please check in with the hunt secretary each day.

Registration will open at 6:30 and the hunts will start at 8:00 a.m.

TEST SITES! We respectfully request that all handlers refrain from visiting or viewing test sites one week prior to the test dates. Only hunt committee, category judges, marshals, and officials shall be allowed at the individual sites until Saturday. We have adopted this policy in order to ensure fairness to all participants.

DIRECTIONS TO HUNT SITE:

Coming in from south of Alexandria on I-49

Travel north on I-49

Take exit #84 marked Pineville Expressway (Hwy 167 north)

Continue north until exit: US Hwy 167 "Monroe", exit and turn right

Turn right again just past Wal-Mart (Esler Field Road) Hwy 116, go to four-way stop, turn right,

Go Approx. 5.4 miles and turn Left after the second bridge on Rifle Range Road.

Go Approx. 1.5 miles and turn Left on Mill Creek Road

Go 0.2 miles and turn Right on Brushy Road

Go approx. 2.5 Miles and turn Right on Buckhorn Road, this will take you directly to the hunt Headquarters at the Twin Lakes Pavilion.

Coming from north of Alexandria On I-49

Travel south on I-49, Take US Hwy 165 north (towards Monroe)

Cross over Red River and you will continue north on Hwy 165

Turn Right just past Wal-Mart (Esler Field Rd.) Hwy 116, the road will come to a four way stop.

Turn Right, go approx. 5.4 miles and turn Left after the second bridge on Rifle Range Rd.

Go approx. 1.5 miles and turn Left on Mill Creek Rd.,

Go 0.2 miles and turn Right on Brushy Road,

Go approx. 2.5 miles Turn Right on Buckhorn Rd.,

This will take you to the hunt headquarters at the Twin Lakes Pavilion.
