Dear Hunt Test Enthusiasts,

Welcome to the Colorado River Retriever Club Spring Hunt Test, February 18-19, 2012! We are most excited to be entering into a new partnership with the City of Texas City and we hope to make this an annual event! You will notice a great deal of support from the city in terms of grounds, equipment, and people. Our plans are to make this a very special event for all!

Additionally, the young people serving as bird technicians and in various other capacities are members of the Agriculture Department of Texas City High School. The funds raised will provide additional financial support for the TCHS Shooting Sports Team (Skeet and Trap) that receives its primary funding through the Mayor's Cup Charity Skeet Shoot. The Mayor's Cup is an annual event that is conducted by the Mayor of Texas City, the Honorable Matthew T. Doyle, who is an avid water fowler and outdoorsman. Please support the efforts of these young people by purchasing lunch and concessions on the grounds.

As always CRRC will host our tailgate party on Saturday night with food and refreshments. Please join us under the big white tent for an evening of fun and celebration!

Finally, we are most excited to bring some of the Hunting Retriever Club's best judges to town to put on a classic set of tests. You will notice that in addition to some Texas folks, we have brought in judges from Tennessee, Mississippi, and Louisiana to make the tests special.

Our Hunt Test Hotel is the Holiday Inn Express, 2440 Gulf Freeway (Interstate 45) South, Texas City, Texas 77590. The phone number is 409.986.6700. The rate for the test is \$82.00 per night and the hotel is dog friendly. Make sure to mention that you are with CRRC for this special rate. NOTE: **This room block expires on February 1st and the rates will go up after that date!**

Directions to the Hotel

From Houston and parts north:

Take Interstate 45 South toward Galveston
Take exit 15 and stay on the feeder
Go left under the freeway and turn left again on FM 2004
Turn left on the frontage road for I-45
The hotel will be on the right

From Baytown and parts east (like Louisiana):

Take Interstate 10 West toward Houston
Take exit 798 for HWY 146
Turn left (south) under the freeway and stay on Hwy 146 through La Porte, Seabrook, and Kemah
Take the exit for FM 1764 and turn right on FM 1764
Go about 4 miles and take the Century Blvd exit
Stay on the access road for about 1 mile
The hotel will be on your right immediately after crossing FM 2004

From the Hunt Grounds:

When on FM 1764 take the CENTURY BLVD exit
Go through 2 lights. Hotel is on the right.

Directions to the Hunt Grounds

From the Holiday Inn Express

Option 1:

Exit the hotel and go under FM 1764
Take the first left and enter the ramp on to FM 1764
Go about 7 miles and turn left on to FM 146
Go about 2.5 miles and turn left on Attwater Avenue
Test site is about 1.5 miles on your right
5188 Attwater Avenue, Texas City

Option 2:

Exit the hotel and go under FM 1764
Take the first left and enter the ramp on to FM 1764
Go about 3 miles and exit on Hwy 3 (by Mainland Center Hospital)
Turn left (north) on Hwy 3 and go 2 miles to South Humble Camp Road
Turn right on Humble Camp Road and go 1 mile to Attwater Avenue
Turn right on Attwater and go ½ mile to grounds on the left
5188 Attwater Avenue, Texas City

Option 3:

Exit the hotel and go left (north) on FM 2004
Stay on 2004 for 2 ½ miles until you reach until Hwy 3
Turn right on Hwy 3 and go south for about 2 miles
Turn left on South Humble Camp Road and go 1 mile to Attwater Avenue
Turn right on Attwater and go ½ mile to grounds on the left
5188 Attwater Avenue, Texas City

From Houston and parts north:

Take exit 16 (FM 1764) toward Texas City
Go about 7 miles and turn left on to FM 146
Go about 3 miles and turn left on Attwater Avenue
Test site is about 1.5 miles on your right
5188 Attwater Avenue, Texas City

From Baytown and parts east (like Louisiana):

Take Interstate 10 West toward Houston
Take exit 798 for Hwy 146
Turn left (south) under the freeway and stay on Hwy 146 through La Porte, Seabrook, and Kemah
About 2.6 miles after you cross the Dickinson Bayou Bridge turn right on Attwater Ave.
Test site is about 1.5 miles on your right
5188 Attwater Avenue, Texas City
