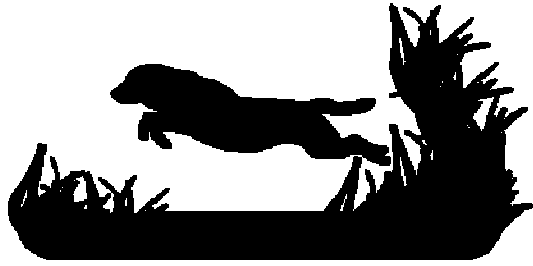

Our club is offering the convenience of entries with Hunt Secretary.com. You can opt to register via US Mail by completing the premium and sending a check or take advantage of easy online entry and credit card payment. There will be a \$5 fee for entries made after the closing date 02/26/2010.

Hunt Test grounds – We will be hosting our test at the Dixieland Retrievers training grounds. Stay on the roads and do not create trails across the pastures. Do not leave trash or cigarette butts at the test sites.

Our club will be offering lunches for purchase on both days of the test.

There will be a tailgate dinner on Saturday evening and a raffle. It looks to be a good raffle. Please support our club by staying for the raffle as this is how we make money to hold hunt tests.

Directions:

**From Dallas:** take I30 to Greenville, take Hwy 69 south towards Emory (through Lone Oak but not all the way to Emory). At the stop light in Point, take a right on Hwy 47 (S 1<sup>st</sup>), we are 9/10 of a mile on the right.

**From Tyler:** take Hwy 69 through Lindale-Mineola-Emory, and on to Point. At the stop light in Point, take a left on Hwy 47 (S 1<sup>st</sup>), we are 9/10 of a mile on the right.
