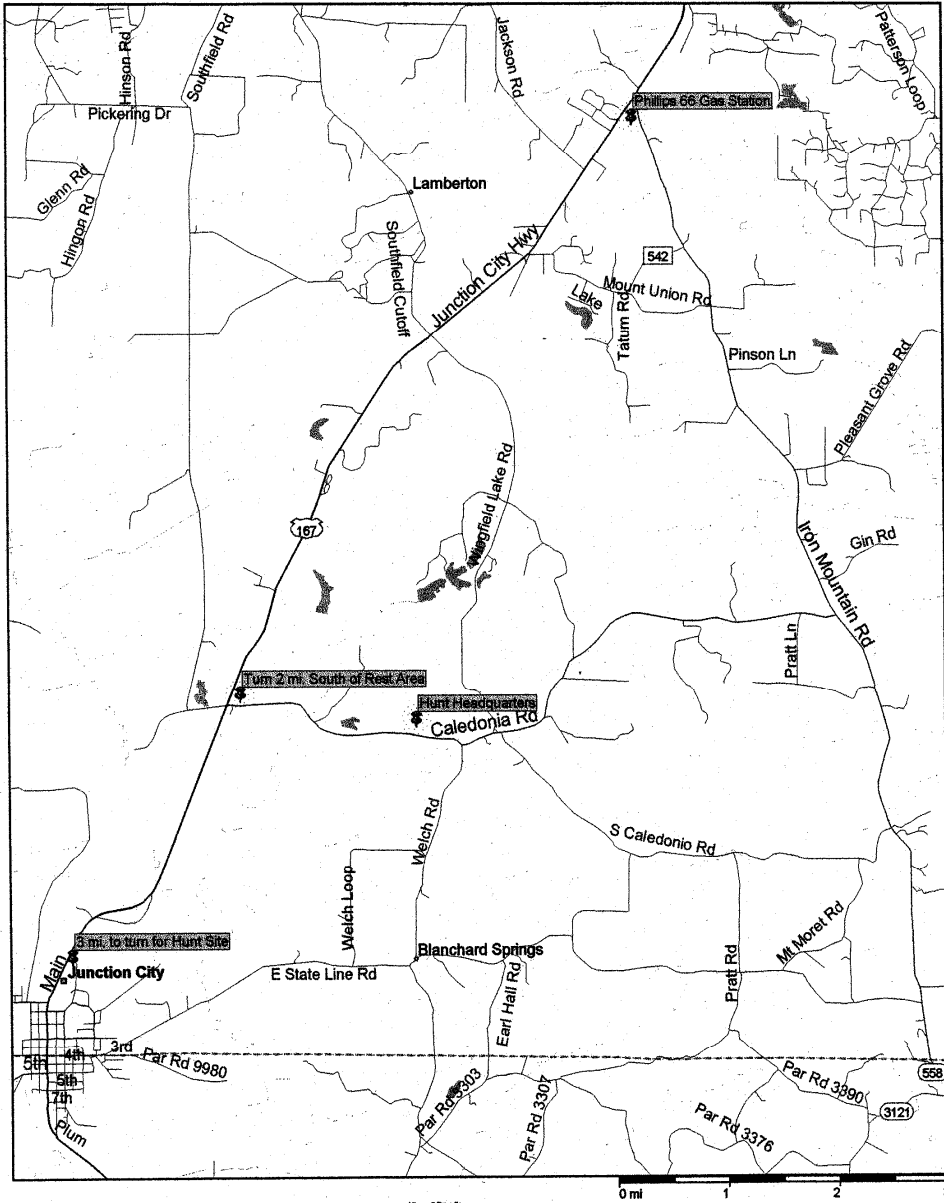

Take US Hwy 167 S. Continue past the Georgia Pacific Sawmill on the West side of Hwy 167 to the State Roadside park on the East side of Hwy 167. Go approx. 2 mi. past the roadside park to Caledonia Rd and turn East (approx. 12 mi. from Kings Inn Motel to Caledonia rd.). Go approx. 2 mi. to Hunt Headquarters.

From Junction City

Take US Hwy 167 N. from Junction City. Go approx. 3 mi. to Caledonia Road and turn East. Go approx. 2 mi. to Hunt Headquarters.
