General Information & Policies

REMEMBER GUN SAFETY

All Seasoned and Finished Handlers **MUST** handle and shoot the shotgun using primer loads. A handler demonstrating poor gun safety while handling the shotgun during an HRC hunt test can and will be disqualified.

- **Remember Gun Safety!**
- **ALL participants**, including handlers, gunners at stakes with live ammunition, judges, and marshals, **MUST have a valid hunting license from their home state.** WSC will obtain all required permits from the state of South Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission to host this event.
- **No training on the hunt test grounds.** Heeling sticks and electronic training collars may not be used on the grounds. Abuse will not be tolerated.
- Requests for refunds from pre-registered entries will be given consideration in the cases of injured dogs, bitches in season, or dire family emergency. Refunds may be requested by filling out a request form and submitting proper documentation. Requests for refunds will be reviewed by the hunt test committee, and approved refunds will be mailed. No refunds will be given during the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Judge or the Test Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the Test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, inclement weather, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the host club. In such case, the Hunt Test may be rescheduled if possible.
- **Bitches in season are not allowed on the hunt test grounds.**
